Words from the Chronicler

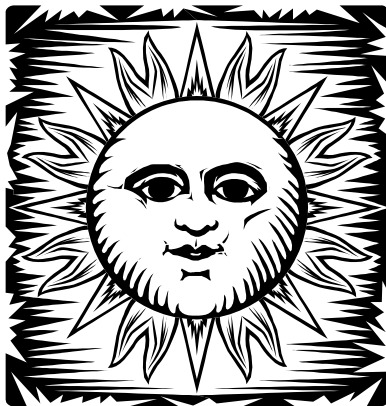
We have been a busy little shire this last few months, what with holding two events within a month of each other, both which seen people making things to be proud of.

Knowne World Academy of the Rapier More KWAR in 2004

KWAR is the premiere forum for SCA rapier instruction in the SCA. **KWAR 2004** will be held at the Omni Southpark Hotel in Austin, Texas, USA (Bryn Gwlad, Ansteorra) on Thursday, 7 October through Sunday, 10 October. So what will be different?

KWAR attendees will have the opportunity to participate in a number of activities -- SCA and non-SCA -- that will make your trip unique.

On Thursday, October 7th the English Civil War Society of America (ECWSA) will be holding a one day event, Academy of the Soldier. This fun event will feature Blacksmithing demonstrations, training in the use of matchlock muskets (yes, you get to fire them), live fire cannon demonstrations and more. Remember this is NOT an SCA event, it is an ECWSA event. See their web page at: <http://academy.swordworks.org>.

On Friday, **KWAR** will kick off with a full day at the Garriot Estate on Lake Austin.

We will run melee workshops including bridge battles across actual bridges, town battles in a small village of real buildings, fort battles in a fully enclosed wooden fort, and ship battles on a model of a renaissance sailing ship. You can also Play your Prize in a scale replica of the Globe Theater. Friday night will feature a meet & greet reception in the Hospitality Suite at the Omni Hotel.

On Saturday and Sunday, Like the KWARs that have come before us we will offer classes for the dedicated rapier fighter. We will emphasize period fighting styles, advanced techniques, cutting edge ideas & equipment and other instruction that is hard for most SCAers to find locally.

For those NOT interested in rapier classes, a group of our talented local shoppers will organize a grand shopping trip we call the Silk Road Pilgrimage. The expedition starts at Ginger's Embroidery and The Leather Factory. The route continues through Silk Road with their selection of unique buttons, silks, linen and embroidered fabrics. Dine at the Central Market Café followed by a trip through Central Market (a market with the feel of an international bazaar). There are other unique shops nearby to explore including Book Stop and a grand finish at The Three Chocolatiers. This will not be an SCA activity.

Saturday Night brings the KWAR Gaming Revel at the Omni which features period games and dancing. Local musicians will provide live period music. For those who would rather explore Austin's night life, some of our locals have organized a non-SCA Pub Crawl to many interesting locations, including some of Austin's famous live music venues.

KWAR will also be offering a CD with articles, instruction and more. With a CD we can pack in 700 megabytes of information, graphics and video. And of

course there will be T-shirts. Check online for information about reserving yours! Attendees of KWAR get a special rate when they stay at the luxurious Omni Southpark Hotel located at 4140 Governors Row; Austin, Texas 78744; Phone: (512) 448-2222. The hotel has a nice restaurant, free airport shuttle service, plush rooms, a fancy coffee bar in the mornings, free wireless broadband Internet and much more for the price of \$79 per night for 1, 2, 3 or 4 occupants.

The cost for KWAR will be \$25 with pre-paid reservations or \$30 at the door. We will offer an additional \$5 discount to instructors. The deadline for pre-registration is Friday, September 10, 2004

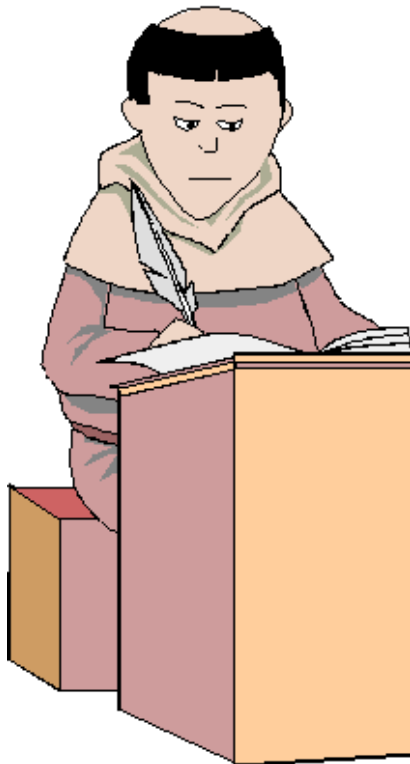
