The Shire of Glen Rathlin is proud to announce Viceroy Tournament V for the Crown Principality of Insula Draconis.

The Site:

Crawfordsburn Scout Camp, 20 Bridge Road South, Helen's Bay, Co Down.

The site will open at 6pm on Friday 28 October 2005 and will close at 2pm on Sunday 30 October 2005.

Accommodation:

The site consists of 42 beds, complete with bedding and pillows, so no need to bring sleeping bags. Beds will be assigned on a first come basis. There are showering facilities available throughout the site.

Please note that the site is strictly dry. There is also camp space available for the braver amongst us and for the less brave, or those of us who just like the comforts of home, there are B&B's, hostels and hotels in the surrounding area.

Cost:

Full weekend rate includes site fee, cooked breakfast on both Saturday and Sunday, lunch on Saturday and feast Saturday night.

Weekend Rate with accommodation: £25.

Weekend Rate with camping space: £17

Weekend Rate with no accommodation: £12.

Day rates, children's prices and family cap will be available on request.

All UK booking must be accompanied by payment. Any booking from the 1st October will incur a £3 late fee.

Reservations:-

Payment for all reservations, must be received by the 31st August 2005, after this date, any bookings made for which payment is not received will have their beds & feast space opened to other paying attendees. All bookings post 31 August must be accompanied by payment; until the payment is received the place will not be considered reserved. Any bookings from the 1st October will incur a £3 late fee. All cheques made payable to "SCA Northern Ireland" and sent to the event steward.

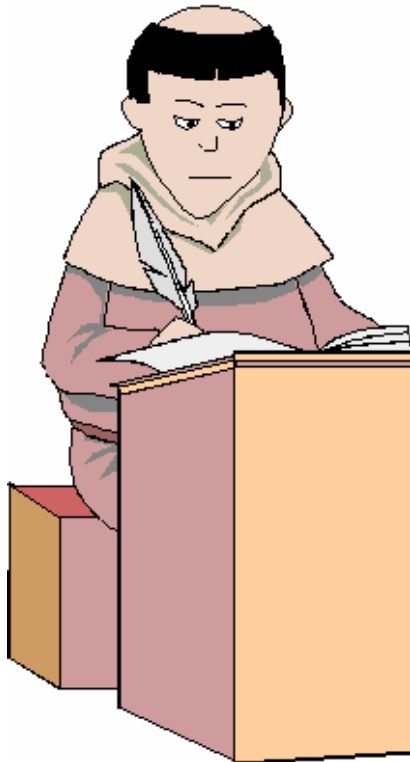
